

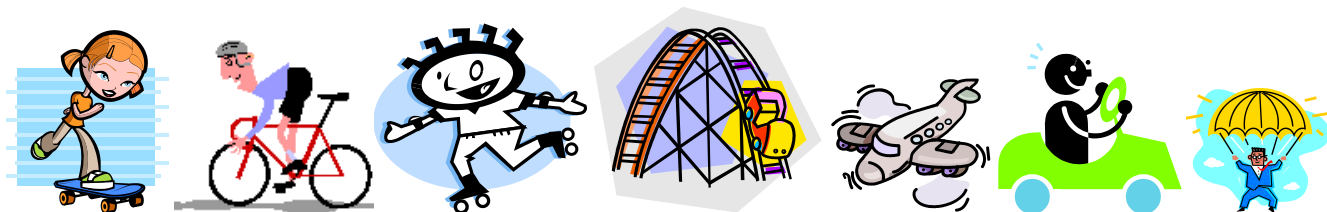


Motion Stories Due: _____

Your mission: Create a motion graph of your own making and write a story about your trip.

The specs:

1. Choose ONE graph type (Distance-Time) or (Speed-Time)
2. You have to draw a graph (no numbers necessary – this is conceptual) that contains at least 5 different forms of motion.
3. Write a story that includes all elements of your graph in your story. Story must be no more than no less than one paragraph, but no more than one page.
4. Provide an illustration of your story.
5. You can use any mode of transportation [walking, running, flying, driving, skateboarding, rolling, etc. or a combination of modes).
6. Use proper grammar, spelling, and punctuation.
7. Use terms such as acceleration, speed, velocity, motion, movement, reference point, fast, slow, constant, stopped, at rest, etc.
8. Keep it clean! Anything inappropriate or offensive will receive a zero.
9. May be typed (single-spaced ok, no larger than size 14 font) or hand-written (NEATLY)!
10. Can do this on construction paper, card stock, no larger than 8 ½" X 14"
